#### FUTURE SERVICE DESIGN PLANNING

#### U. S. 35 West Construction

During the next five (5) years it is anticipated that construction of U. S. 35 West between Western Avenue and Gettysburg Avenue will begin. The Year 2000 Plan Service Design Group proposes discontinuation of the west end of Route 2-Home Avenue and the Lakeside Drive-Gettysburg Avenue split-route on Route 8-Lakeview Avenue. To supplement the loss of service to these areas, the group proposed instituting Route 8 service on Dearborn Avenue, McCall Avenue, Gettysburg Avenue to the V. A. Center loop.

#### Research Park

Miami Valley's Research Park located in eastern Montgomery and western Greene Counties currently beyond transit service coverage. The Service Design Group proposes extension of Route 7-Watervliet Avenue beyond its current terminus at Patterson Road Woodman Drive to Research Park Drive and County Line Road during the next five (5) years. The group also proposes initiation of employer sponsored subscription bus/van service and express bus service into the area during this same period.

### Lincoln Park

Residential development is currently underway in an area in Kettering referred to as Lincoln Park. Much of this development is higher density apartment/condominium complexes. Route 21-Shroyer Road current operates within walking distance (one (1)-quarter mile) of a portion of Lincoln Park. The group proposes that Route 21-Shroyer Road split-route at Lincoln Park Boulevard-Ackerman Boulevard during the next five (5) years to serve this newly developing area.

### Poe Avenue/I-70 and I-75 Industrial Park

This area of office/light industrial development has experience considerable growth during the past five (5) years. Early attempts to serve the area using an express bus originating from downtown were not successful. The group proposed that Route 17-Vandalia be diverted to operate on Poe Avenue during the next

three (3) years. In addition, the group proposes initiation of employer sponsored subscription bus/van service and express bus service into the area during this same period.

#### Cox International Airport

Dayton's airport has experienced recent expansion in cargo handling, office space, and passenger traffic. More expansion will occur in the near future with improvements to the main terminal, increased cargo handling, and further development of office/light industry in and near the airport grounds. An early attempt to operate a work-trip express service from downtown to the terminal was unsuccessful. The Service Design Group proposes initiation of employer sponsored subscription bus/van service during the next three (3) years. The group also proposes marketing the concept of using taxi/vans as feeders to existing or new fixed route service to Vandalia.

#### Salem Mall Area

The Salem Mall Area (Shiloh Springs Road and Salem Avenue) has two (2) major hubs of commercial activities. Additional commercial activities are currently under construction or planned for the near future. Residential and office development could expand assuming the Trotwood Connector (U. S. 35 West) is routed through the Salem Mall Area. The group proposes Route 15-Englewood be used as an express service between Salem Mall and downtown when Route 5-Salem Avenue is extended to Salem Mall. In addition, the group proposes initiation of a crosstown service between Trotwood and Main Street (S. R. 48) to feed the mall and Route 15 express to downtown. The Salem Mall could thus serve as a northwestern hub with service feeding from Trotwood, Englewood, Brookville, Dayton, and Shiloh.

### Dayton Mall Area

The Service Design Group proposes that the Dayton Mall Area be considered as the second major transit hub and transfer point in Montgomery County. The group proposes express service connecting Dayton Mall and Downtown using I-75. This proposal includes modifying routes and schedules for existing and new services to focus on the Dayton Mall transfer/collection point rather than downtown. The group proposes that a Dayton Mall Transit Marketing Plan be developed to implement this new regional hub, including all capital, operating and promotional/educational programs necessary to initiate the plan. The group supports development of this plan during the next three (3) years, with implementation to follow within three (3) years of the plan completion. Much emphasis was placed by the group on the need to establish the Dayton Mall hub concept with strong long-term commitment by the Board, Staff and community for its success.
